***NOTE:** If you are sharing the responsibility for mentoring an MIT student, your compensation will reflect the percentage of mentoring for which you are responsible. For example, if you are the student's mentor for 40% of the time, you will receive 40% of the compensation; that is, 40% of \$200 (\$80) or a voucher for 40% of the cost of a three credit graduate course (\$533).

As of last year, 10 clock hours will be available each semester or 20 clock hours per year per mentor. Your student teacher's supervisor will have clock hour forms available for you.
