SO 200 (Introduction Cultural Anthropology) is offered on site on the beautiful island of Oahu during Jan Term 2010.

If you are interested in this study program, apply online between **February 17** and **March 1**. Here are few details you may want to consider before you apply. Please read carefully.

1. The study program meets the Global Perspectives graduation requirement (3 credits).
2. The study program is limited to 20-24 students.
3. The course is taught and administered by Raja S. Tanas, Professor of Sociology.
4. A completed application contains one reference from a professor, employer, or pastor.
5. All students are eligible to apply.
6. All majors are eligible to apply.
7. The fee is **\$1970.00**. For students whose permanent residence is on the Island of Oahu within easy commuting distance of the hotel, the fee is \$830.
8. Early Bird Special. You will receive a \$100 credit if you make each payment on time and turn-in all the required paperwork to Off-Campus Programs by November 5.

**The fee covers** hotel accommodations, bus pass for the duration of the program, admission fees to all museums, sites, cultural events, social activities, and all other costs associated with the administration of the program. The fee also includes **one evening meal a day, Monday through Friday**. Other meals are the responsibility of the student. Please note that the hotel room has a full kitchen where you can prepare your meals.

**Fee for Oahu students excludes** the following: hotel space, bus pass for the duration of the tour, and the five meals a week. That is, the \$830.00 fee for Oahu students covers admission to all museums, sites, cultural events, social activities, and all other costs associated with the administration of the program. The \$830 fee also includes the **farewell banquet** that is provided to all participants. These students will pay a non-refundable deposit of \$270 upon acceptance, \$300 on May 15, and \$260 on June 15.

9. Please note that airfare, the textbook, and personal expenses are **not** included in the fees.

10. Students accepted in the study program are eligible to apply for a \$200.00 Off-Campus Programs travel grant. The deadline for applying for this is **September 17, 2009**.

11. Do not purchase air tickets until you are formally accepted in the program.

12. All correspondence with accepted students will take place via **Whitworth e-mail accounts**. You are responsible to read your e-mail messages in timely manner.
