**Included:**

- Round trip airfare Seattle/London
- Round trip airfare Spokane/Seattle for those students leaving from Spokane
- Tube Pass – subway and bus transportation in London
- Hotel accommodations in London including full English breakfast
- Tickets to a minimum of 4 plays/musical events
- 2 or 3 full-day excursions that will include a comfortable coach (bus) and guide plus lunch.
- Several tours within London
- Depending on costs/exchange rate, we will try to return money to you for additional tickets, events, meals

**Not Included:**

- Travel to and from Seattle from cities other than Spokane
- Spending money for meals other than breakfast (we will share lots of ideas about how to eat inexpensively) as well as gifts, etc. Try to plan on at least \$500.
- Passport Fees (if you don't already have a passport)
- Textbook
- Optional: Travel during the long weekend (January 15 - 18). However, many students will stay in London where your hotel is already paid for.

**Requirements:**

Two or three pre-trip meetings in Fall 2009, to be scheduled at a later date. There are no post-trip meetings although we usually have an optional get-together in Spring Term.

Written work on the study tour is in a journal format. You will receive a detailed outline of expectations, assignments, and questions for your journal at the pre-trip meetings.
