### Student Eligibility:

Scholarship will be awarded based on application and recommendations of Theology Admissions committee.

- **Good academic standing:** Scholarships are awarded for an academic year, but are subject to review at the end of each semester for renewal for subsequent semesters.
  - Student must maintain a 3.0 or above GPA to be eligible for additional terms.
  - Review will be completed at the end of term by financial aid office. If student does not meet eligibility requirement, scholarship will be removed from student's award for remainder of year.
- **Financial need:** A student must have completed the FAFSA (Federal Application for Student Aid) form in order to qualify for need determination. Financial need will be determined by both the FAFSA information and answer to the essay questions. The FAFSA applicable to this application period is the 2011-12 FAFSA.
