



## Crowell Scholarship 2009-10

This scholarship was established to assist students enrolled in the M.A. in Theology program with tuition costs.

### Student Eligibility:

Scholarship will be awarded based on application and recommendations of Theology Admissions committee.

- **Major Requirement:**
  - Matriculated student in M.A. in Theology program
  
- **Good academic standing:** Scholarships are awarded for an academic year, but are subject to review at the end of each semester for renewal for subsequent semesters.
  - Student must maintain a 3.0 or above GPA to be eligible for additional terms.
  - Review will be completed at the end of fall term by M.A. in Theology program faculty. Financial Aid office will be notified if student is not meeting eligibility requirement to renew scholarship for spring term. Scholarship will be removed from student's award for remainder of year.
  - If student achieves 3.0 or better GPA at end of spring term, they will be responsible for contacting financial aid office to determine if scholarship can be reinstated for summer term.
  
- **Financial need:** A student must have completed the FAFSA form in order to qualify for need determination. Financial need will be determined by both the FAFSA information and answer to the essay questions.

### Application Process:

Student will submit a one-page essay to [finaidsscholars@whitworth.edu](mailto:finaidsscholars@whitworth.edu)

**The subject line of the e-mail should be: Crowell Scholarship Application**

The essay should contain the following:

1. Explanation for his/her reason for attending the master's program, including individual goals upon completion of the program,
2. An explanation of unmet financial needs not indicated by FAFSA information.

Selection Committee: Administrative staff of Whitworth University Master of Arts in Theology program in conjunction with the Whitworth Financial Aid Office.

Designated Amount: varies

### Awarding and Notification Process:

1. Use of Funds: educational related expenses
2. Notification of Recipient: by Scholarship Coordinator. The award for the upcoming year will be credited to the student's account in the semester following the notification of the award.
3. Letters of Acknowledgement/thank you: You will be requested to write a thank you letter to the Crowell Trust. The request for the letter will be sent to you from Institutional Advancement office.
