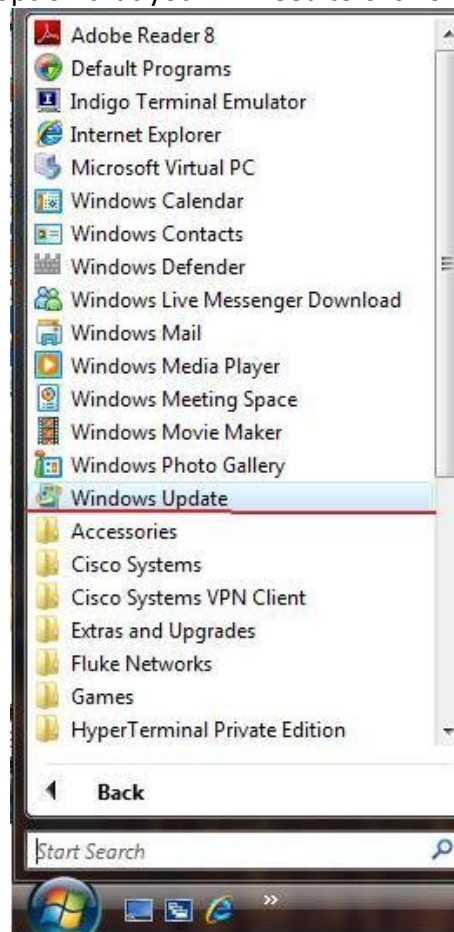



Installing Windows Updates for Vista

From the windows icon in the bottom left corner of your screen, expand the 'All Program' and you will find the 'Windows Update' option that you will need to click on to start the process:




Click the 'Check for updates' button:




Once your computer finds an update you will need to click the install option:
