

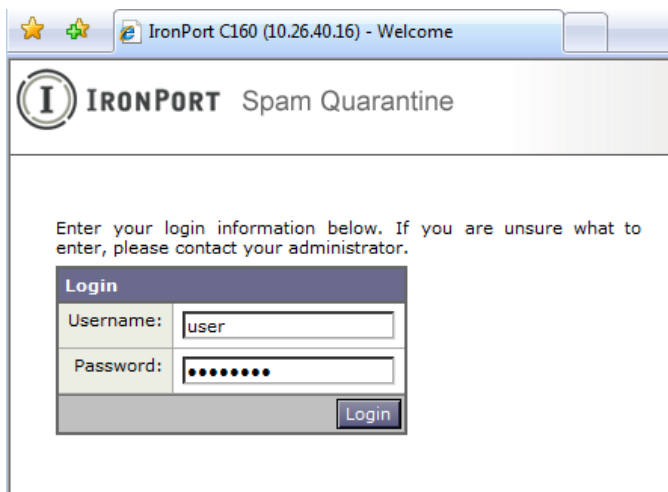
IronPort Spam Quarantine

Log in to your Spam Quarantine by either clicking on the “View All Quarantined Messages” link in your e-mail or going to the following URL using Internet Explorer: <https://email-gw2.whitworth.edu:83>. You will need to log in using your network/e-mail username and password:

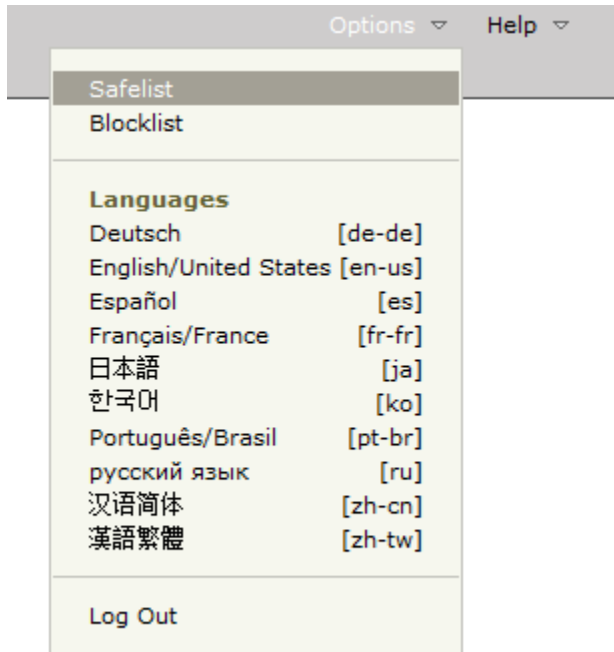

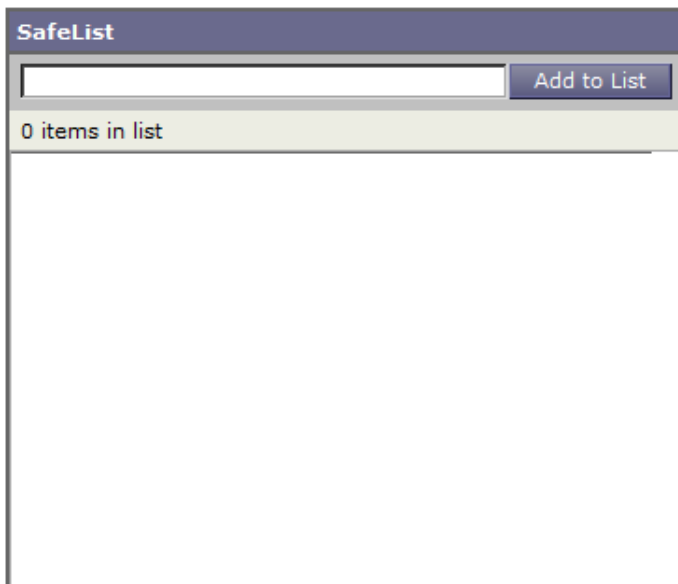

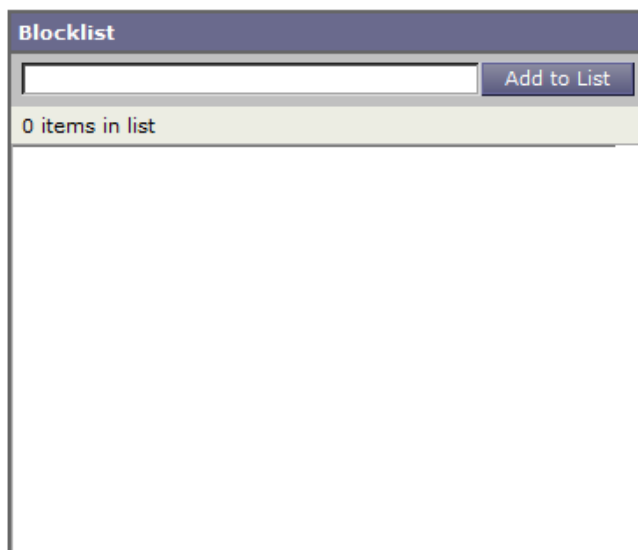
