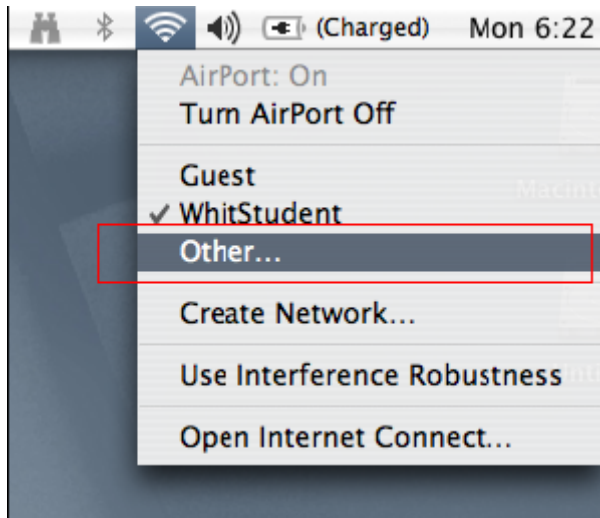
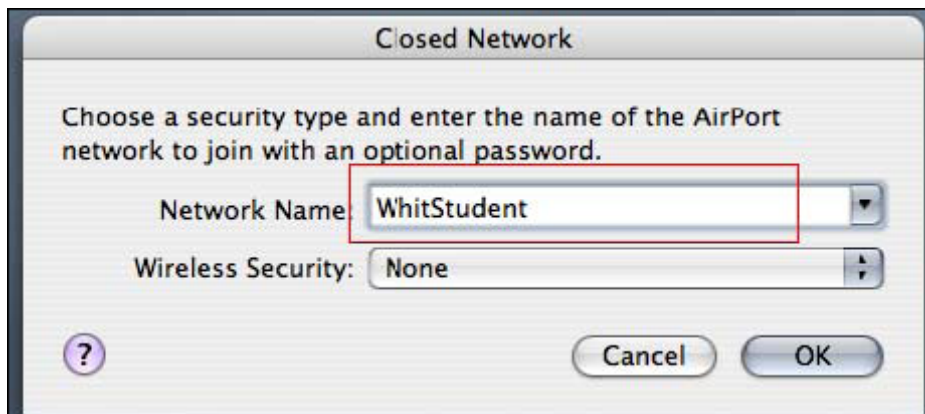


## Steps to connect to the Whitworth Student Wireless Network (WhitStudent) with a Mac

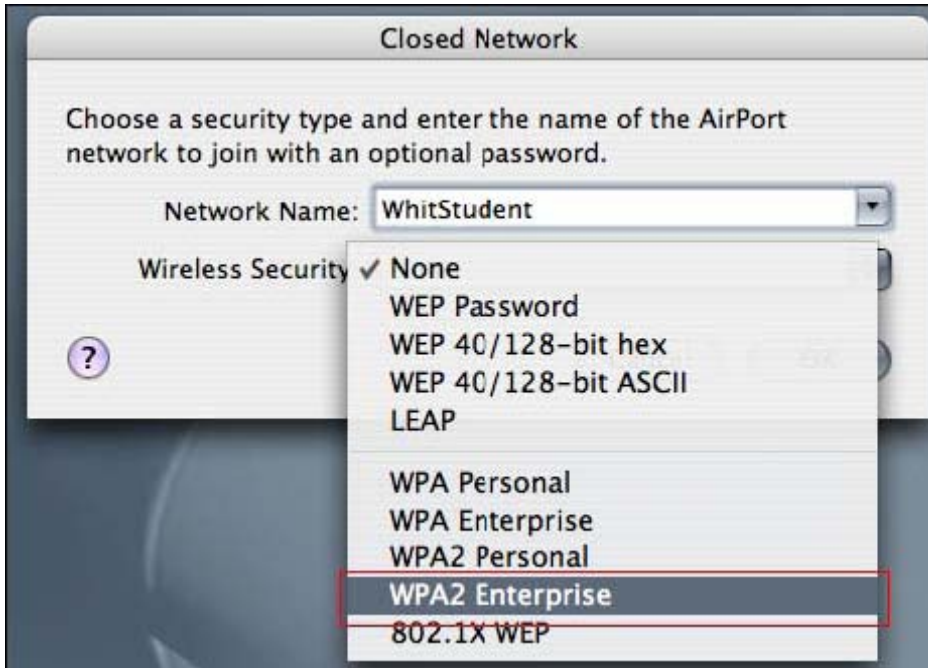
1. Click on your AirPort icon and select **Other Network**:



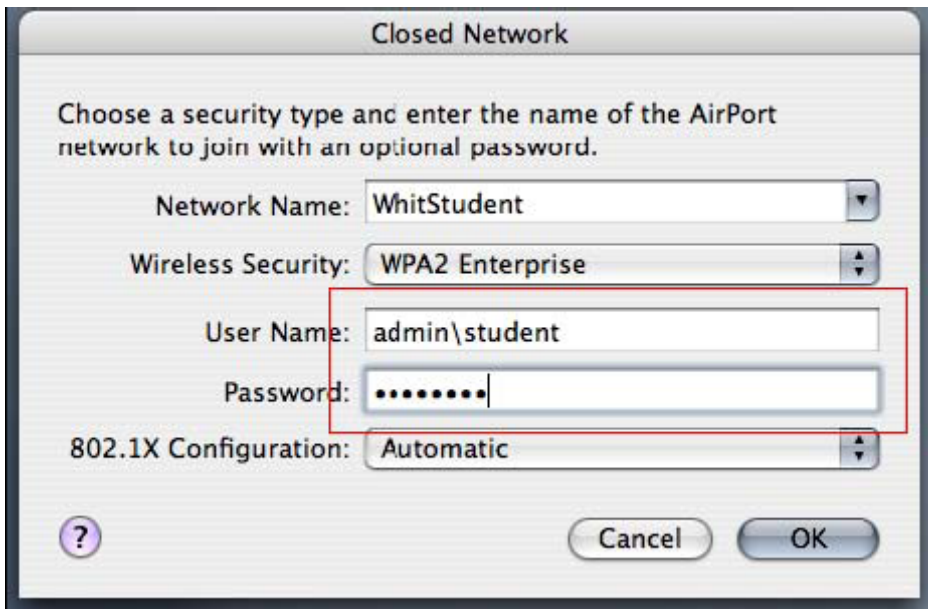
2. For the network name type **WhitStudent**



3. Click Wireless Security and choose **WPA2 Enterprise**



4. Enter your **admin\username** where username is your Whitworth Username, and enter your password. Click **OK**.



- When it asks you to verify the Certificate click **Show Certificate**.



- Check **Always trust these certificates**, and click **Continue**.



SafeConnect is a new system Whitworth is using to ensure all computers connected to the network are running current antivirus software. If your computer is not running the current required software it will be blocked from sending traffic across the network. Below are instructions for Macintosh.

The first time you connect to the network or internet you will need to do the following:

**(Note: This is only required the first time)**

- 1) Open a web browser and go to any web page other than [www.whitworth.edu](http://www.whitworth.edu), like [www.cnn.com](http://www.cnn.com); you will get following page.

Netscape & FireFox users, please click "Save" and when the file finishes downloading, click on the installer.

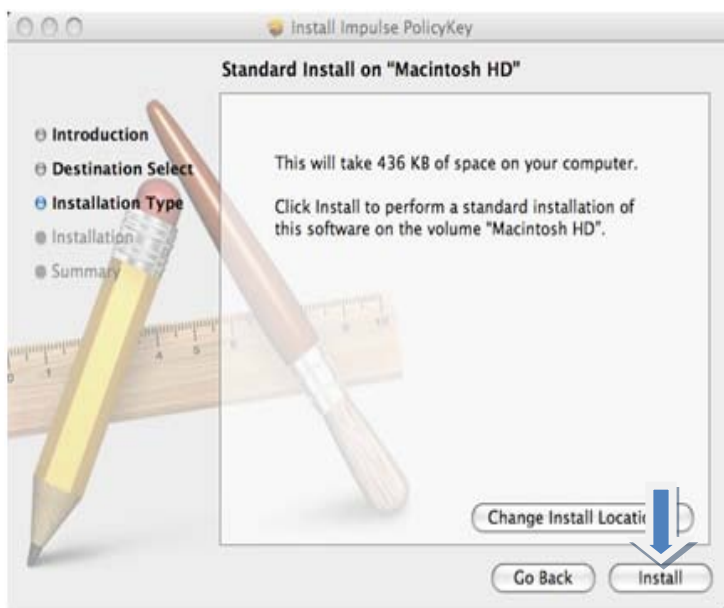
**I DO NOT ACCEPT**

- 3) After accepting the terms it will bring you to the download page. Save the Policy Key software to the desktop and the installation should start automatically. If it doesn't go to the location it was saved and click on the PKG file. Once the installer has begun you should get the following screen. Click **Continue**.



- 4) On the next screen of the installer click **Install** to continue. You may be asked to provide your Mac OS X administrator username and password to continue.



- 5) Once the installation is complete you should get the following “Install Succeeded” message. Click **Close** to finish the installation. You should now be able to reach the Internet.
