

International Baccalaureate

Whitworth University recognizes the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma and subject examinations; the university awards credit on a course-by-course basis for only high level courses passed with a score of 5 or higher. A maximum of 32 semester credits, including other kinds of advanced placement, can be granted for the IB subject examinations. Credit may be granted in the following subjects: art, biology, chemistry, computer science, English, economics, history, languages, mathematics, physics, psychology, sociology, and theatre arts. Other subjects will be evaluated by the appropriate academic departments. No credit will be awarded for standard level exams.
