- HI 210 Becoming a Historian (3 credits)


## SOPHOMORE YEAR

15 credits

## Fall

- One upper-division American history course (3 credits, HI 323 or HI 375W suggested)
- One upper-division history elective (3 credits)

Spring

- HI 102 The Pacific World (3 credits)
- One upper-division history elective (3 credits)
- One upper-division European history elective (3 credits)

JUNIOR YEAR
15 credits
Fall

- HI 384 Pacific Northwest History (3 credits)
- One upper-division history elective (3 credits)
- One upper-division course in non-Western history (3 credits)

Spring

- One upper-division European history elective (3 credits)
- EDU 350 Methods of Teaching in Middle and High School (3 credits)

SENIOR YEAR
2 credits

- EDU 453W Social Studies in Secondary School (2 credits)

One upper-division course must be a $W$ course at the 400 level.
