Tips for a Good Video Recording

1. Find a quiet place to do your recording.

- -Put phone on silent mode
- -Avoid times of day with too many interruptions
- -Use a space without loud air conditioning/heating noise

2. Make sure the room has good lighting

- -Don't sit in front of a window
- -Turn on a few lights to keep shot well lit, not dark

3. Compose the shot

- -Choose background that is not distracting or cluttered
- -Aim camera level with your face so you look into camera
- -Avoid tilting laptop up at ceiling to film lights or nostrils!

4. Make a short test recording

- -You'll need a webcam and microphone
- -Review the test recording for sound quality, good lighting

5. Use *Landscape*, not *Portrait*

-If using phone or tablet, rotate device to record in *landscape* mode, rather than *portrait*. This is much better for viewing.

6. Use a Text Prompt

- -Outline or bulleted list preferrable to a complete script
- -Rehearse so you don't end up reading lines
- -Use large font size readable from 2-4 feet away

7. Pause and Keep Going!

- -Make a mistake while speaking? -Don't stop!
- -Keep recording. Just pause; then continue speaking
- -Edit out mistakes after recording is completed
