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**POSITION SUMMARY:**

Reporting to the Director of Student Health Services, the Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner (ARNP) provides medical services to students in the Whitworth Health Center. This position is 16 hours per week, scheduled on a 9-month basis.

**CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**Patient Care (90%):**

- Perform preventative care, care of acute illness or injury, care of chronic conditions, and care of mental health concerns.
- Independently evaluate and manage patient care through assessment, diagnosis, diagnostic testing, appropriate treatment, and follow-up within the scope of state licensure.
- Provide clinical support for COVID-19 and other communicable disease management, including prevention, evaluation, screening, triage, clinical interventions, laboratory testing, facilitation of care coordination specific to identified communicable disease(s).
- Telehealth and phone visits/medical triage
- Minor office medical procedures
- Document findings and maintain confidentiality and privacy of patients' protected health information in accordance with FERPA and HIPPA regulations.
- Provide safe, effective, and fiscally responsible care for the patient
- Some weekend and evening work required
- Other duties as assigned

**Care Coordination & Health Promotion (10%):**

- Consult and collaborate with Whitworth Counseling Center and other campus resources
- Collaborate with and refer to other healthcare professionals for the care of the patient when indicated
- Provide health and wellness education to patients and the Whitworth community

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:**

- Strong understanding of immunization recommendations for college population.

- Knowledge of common health conditions in the college population and how ambulatory care settings operate.
- Demonstrate knowledge of evidence-based health care of under-represented racial and ethnic groups as well as LGBTQ+ populations.
- Solid understanding of COVID-19 prevention, symptoms, medical monitoring, testing modalities, quarantine/isolation considerations, etc.
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to work effectively with others in a collaborative office environment and as a member of a team.
- Telehealth and/or phone triage skills.
- Procedure skills, such as incision & drainage, skin biopsy, and basic laceration repair.
- Function independently with minimal supervision.
- Perform complex patient care with speed and accuracy in a fast-paced clinical environment.
- Electronic health record experience with a minimum of intermediate level of general computer proficiency (competency in Microsoft office suite, Microsoft Teams, zoom, etc.)

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- **Education:** M.S. Nursing; Family Nurse Practitioner
- **Experience:** Minimum 1- year in Family Practice/Primary Care, Internal Medicine, Ambulatory care or college health setting
- Valid Washington State License as ARNP with active, national board certification; Active DEA Licenses; Current CPR/AED Certification
- A personal commitment to the Christian faith and to the integration of faith and learning
- Demonstrated growth in cultural competence, awareness of societal and structural inequities and proven experience in effectively establishing relationships and positive communications with students and other constituents across multiple dimensions of diversity including, but not limited to, race, gender, varying abilities, nationality, sexual orientation, gender identity, class or religious perspectives
- A commitment to the educational mission of Whitworth University as a comprehensive Christian liberal arts university affiliated with the Presbyterian church

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:** A background check, sexual misconduct check and confirmation of degrees earned will be required of the successful candidate.
