FIRST YEAR

6 credits

-
- Two of the following three requirements (6 credits):

 - HI 131 American History Before 1877
 - HI 182 American History Since 1877

SOPHOMORE YEAR

6-9 credits

-
- One of the following three requirements (3 credits):
 - HI 102 The Pacific World
 - HI 131 American History Before 1877
 - HI 182 American History Since 1877
 - HI 210 Becoming a Historian (3 credits)
 - Optional: History elective (3 credits)

JUNIOR YEAR

12-15 credits

-
- One course upper-division European history (3 credits)
 - One course upper-division American history (3 credits)
 - One course non-Western history (3 credits)
 - One-two History electives (3-6 credits)

SENIOR YEAR

18 credits

-
- One course upper-division European history (3 credits)
 - One course upper-division American history (3 credits)
 - One course non-Western history (3 credits)
 - A 400W level course in history (3 credits)
 - Two History electives (6 credits)

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT (JUNIOR/SENIOR YEAR)

-
- One of the following:
 - Internship (1 course)
 - Field Experience (e.g., student teaching) (1 course)
 - Study Abroad (1 course)
 - Foreign Language (at least two years of one language or one year each of two languages)

A minimum of two courses in the major must be at the 400 level. One of those must be a W course in history.
