## Honors Program Internship Requirements

Students wishing to enroll in an Honors-designated internship must complete the following:

- register for a 1-credit 390H in the discipline of the supervising professor;
- complete an Internship Contract through Career Services, found here: <https://www.whitworth.edu/Administration/StudentLife/CareerServices/Forms/Internships/Contract/index.aspx>
- identify a faculty member to supervise the internship, as well as complete all internships requirements as put forth by the Career Services office.

### Faculty approval

Faculty will determine what work the student will complete to earn the 1-3 credit Honors credit. This might include such things as disciplinary readings and research that accompanies the internship; a journal/blog for the internship; interviews with those at the internship site; a presentation for the internship site and/or the department; a researched paper that integrates readings, interviews, and the internship experience. The faculty member will coordinate with the site supervisor and then oversee the internship experience along with one or more of the suggested experiences.
