Cost: \$3,800

Early Bird Special: The EBS is an incentive program that gives students a \$100 credit *if* they: make ALL payments in time according to the payment plan; turn in all required paperwork in accordance with Off-Campus Programs deadlines; and meet the Health Center's deadlines for fulfilling the Travel Clinic requirement.

Not Included:

- Travel to and from Spokane
- Meals other than breakfast (we will share lots of ideas about how to eat inexpensively, but you should plan on at least \$500, or \$1000 if you have trouble budgeting or have a coffee habit)
- Passport Fees (if you don't already have a passport)
- Guidebook

Requirements:

Meetings — Three pre-trip meetings in Fall 2019, to be scheduled at a later date.

Short essays — Written work on the study tour is a series of short essays. You will receive a detailed outline of expectations, assignments, and questions for these essays at the pre-trip meetings.

Scholarships:

Students will be eligible to apply for a \$500 need-based travel grant. Information about the application for this award will be communicated by Off-Campus Programs upon acceptance to the program.
