

PH261: C.S. Lewis Study Program, Spring, 2020—Informational Sheet

- Instructor: Forrest E. Baird, Philosophy (x4380)
- This is the C.S. Lewis class with a Spring Break “field trip” to the U.K.
- Prerequisites: NONE
- Pre-trip requirements: Regular C.S. Lewis class on Monday nights (6:30-9:30) for the first six weeks of the Spring semester, 2020.
- Post-trip requirements: One additional Monday night session for exam and de-brief. The class will end five weeks before the end of the Spring semester
- *Tentative Itinerary* (**NOTE:** The trip will be 10 or 11 days and will require missing one day of MWF and possibly T/Th classes either immediately before or after Spring Break.)
