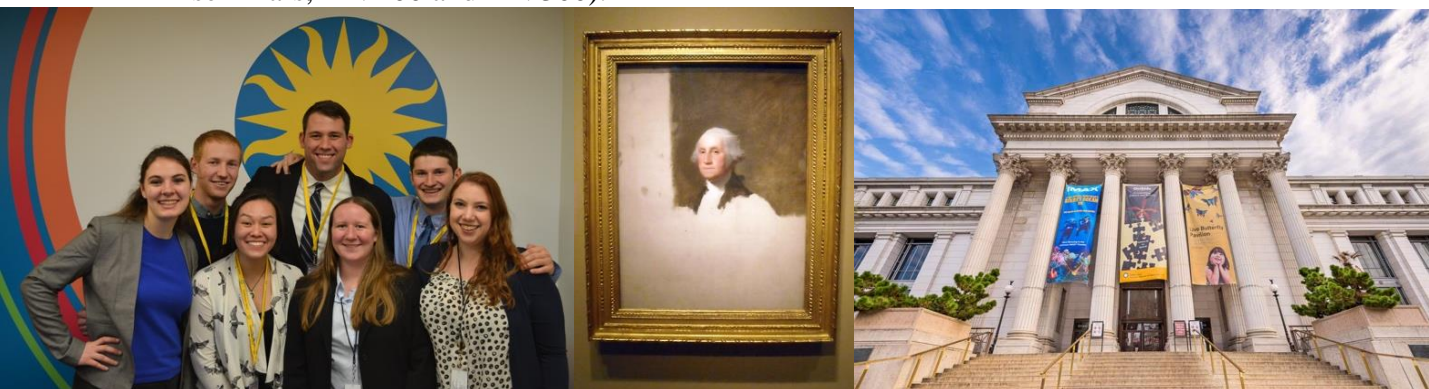
Smithsonian

HN 401/2/3/4H: Smithsonian Seminar fulfills either FA, HU, or USD (3 credits)
CO 350H: Core 350: Religious Liberty (4 credits)
Independent study arranged with on-campus Whitworth major professor (0-3 credits)
- Credits:** 13–19 credits
- Eligibility:** For Honors students and others who are diligent, motivated, independent and reliable. No prerequisites.
- Pre-trip meeting:** There will be one orientation meeting held during Spring semester 2019.



Live, work (at the Smithsonian), and attend classes with Whitworth students and professor in Washington, D.C. The Smithsonian Institution is the world’s largest museum, education, and research complex. It includes iconic museums such as the Freer and Sackler art galleries, the Air & Space Museum, the American History Museum, Natural History Museum and the new Museum of African American History and Culture along with a range of research centers.

- Live on Capitol Hill with other Whitworth interns and college students from CCCU schools around the nation.
- Gain significant work experience and bolster your résumé
- Make valuable connections with Smithsonian researchers and explore the D.C. area.
- Complete all of the requirements for an honors degree (with the exception of the two one-credit honors seminars, HN 200 and HN 300).



Itinerary: The program dates correspond approximately to the Whitworth semester.

Anticipated cost: \$6575.00 (includes, housing, food; excludes airfare, travel).

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Payment Plan:

- \$500 non-refundable deposit within 2 working days of acceptance into program.

Early Bird Special: The EBS is an incentive program that gives students a \$100 credit if they: make ALL payments in time according to the payment plan; turn in all required paperwork in accordance with Off-Campus Programs deadlines; and meet the Health Center's deadlines for fulfilling the Travel Clinic requirement.

Grants/Scholarships:

Students will be eligible to apply for a \$500 need-based travel grant. Information about the application for this award will be communicated by Off-Campus Programs upon acceptance to the program.
