### Tentative Itinerary

### Course Description

Explore culture, history and the arts in New York City, from the artist's point of view! Students are exposed to a variety of art forms, including music, visual art, dance and theatre. The course also includes a participatory, skill-building experience, in which students work with NYC arts professionals to learn performance skills.

Anticipated Cost—\$2650

Early Bird Special: The EBS is an incentive program that gives students a \$100 credit *if* they: make ALL payments in time according to the payment plan; turn in all required paperwork in accordance with Off-Campus Programs deadlines; and meet the Health Center's deadlines for fulfilling the Travel Clinic requirement .

#### Payment Plan:

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due within two working days of program acceptance. Payments of \$360 due on the 15th of May, June, July, August, and September and final payment of \$500 15th of Oct.

Scholarships: Students will be eligible to apply for a \$500 need-based travel grant. Information about the application for this award will be communicated by Off-Campus Programs upon acceptance to the program.
