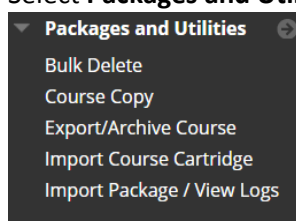


# BLACKBOARD: COPYING, EXPORTING & IMPORTING COURSES (ACADEMIC)

Blackboard allows an instructor to copy courses so that an instructor can create a master course and copy materials and the course structure into different sections or so that an instructor can copy a previous course into a current course. Instructors may also export a course and import a course from one Blackboard system to another. In most cases, instructors will copy their courses.

## Copying Course Content from One Course to Another:

1. Log into **Blackboard**
2. Navigate to your **previous course**
3. Select **Packages and Utilities>Course Copy**



4. Select **Browse**

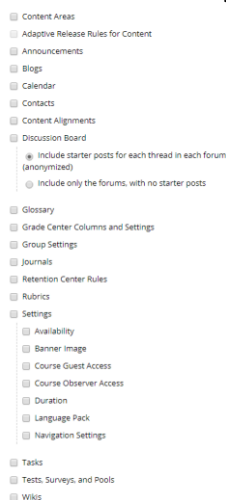

5. Browse and **select the new course in which you wish to copy your content**
6. Select **Submit**
7. Carefully select **Course Materials** you wish to have the system copy into your new course. Do NOT copy enrollments.

**Note:** *If you want graded items such as assignments, tests, discussion boards, journals, blogs, wikis, etc., then you must also copy the grade center columns and settings.*



8. Select **Submit** (Be patient, copying your course takes time and you may not receive an email)

#### **Exporting Course Content:**

1. Log into **Blackboard**
2. Navigate to your **previous course**
3. Select **Packages and Utilities>Export/Archive**
4. Select **Export Package**



5. Select **Course Materials** you wish to have the system copy into your new course  
**Note:** *If you want graded items such as assignments, tests, discussion boards, journals, blogs, wikis, etc., then you must also copy the grade center columns and settings.*
6. Select **Submit** (Be patient, building your package takes time and you may not receive an email)
7. Select **Refresh**
8. **Right click and save** the export file to your computer (This will be a proprietary zipped file)

#### **Importing Course Content:**

1. Log into **Blackboard**
2. Navigate to the **course in which you wish to import your exported data**
3. Select **Packages and Utilities>Import Package**
4. Select **Import Package**



5. **Browse and select the zipped file** you exported from Blackboard
6. Select **Course Materials** you wish to have the system copy into your new course  
**Note:** *If you want graded items such as assignments, tests, discussion boards, journals, blogs, wikis, etc., then you must also copy the grade center columns and settings.*
9. **Submit** (Be patient, building your package takes time and you may not receive an email)

If you wish to have the Grade Center and other tools imported such as the grade center, discussion board or other interactive tools include that specific information in your email.*
