What is Form 8843

The IRS <u>Form 8843</u> is not an income tax return. Form 8843 is merely an informational statement required by the U.S. government for all nonresident aliens present in the U.S. (*this is most all international students!*).

Who Needs to File Form 8843?

All international students whose tax status category is "nonresident alien" must file <u>Form 8843</u>. International students are considered "nonresident alien" for their first five years in the U.S. *Even if you did not work/did not receive income during the tax filing year, you must submit Form 8843*.

How Do I Submit Form 8843?

The <u>Form 8843</u> is typically attached to a tax return. However, if you had NO income and are ONLY filing Form 8843, you can either use the Glacier Tax Prep software Whitworth offers (limited access; first-come first-served) or simply print the form, complete it, and mail it.
